## LIFE REGIMENT HUSSARS

One of the oldest and most legendary regiments still active on the world's stage. Formed by the order of King Gustav I in 1536, this formidable and highly mobile cavalry force have seen action in nearly every century since its inception, still plays a central role in the armed forces of Sweden.

### HISTORY

Tracing their roots back to the 16<sup>th</sup> century, the regiment formed over time by the direction of the kings of Sweden. These cavalry riders formed organized units known as hussars, inspired by the highly effective Polish hussars. The mobility and strategic abilities of the hussars alongside the infantry dragoons, helped Gustav II become known as the 'father of modern warfare'. The regiment has played a crucial role in Sweden's military campaigns, participating in various battles and campaigns throughout the centuries. It saw action in conflicts such as the Great Northern War, the Napoleonic Wars, and the Russo-Swedish War. Over time, the regiment adapted to the changing nature of warfare and evolved into a modern special operations force. In the late 20th century, the Life Regiment Hussars transitioned to its current role as a specialized reconnaissance unit, utilizing advanced technology and tactics to gather vital intelligence and support combat operations. The regiment's long-standing tradition of cavalry warfare is still honored and preserved within its ranks. Today, the Life Regiment Hussars is recognized as one of the elite units of the Swedish Army, known for its professionalism, expertise, and unwavering dedication to serving the nation.

### CAPABILITIES

The Life Regiment Hussars, are distinguished by their exceptional capabilities in signals, intelligence and survival. They specialize in gathering crucial intelligence through precise and covert reconnaissance missions, utilizing advanced surveillance skills and survival expertise. With their keen observation skills and intelligence training, they excel at gathering intel and providing real-time situational awareness. The Hussars' ability to swiftly transition from reconnaissance to engaging in direct combat showcases the versatility and adaptability of the cavalry on the battlefield. Their seamless integration with larger military operations and unwavering dedication to excellence make the Life Regiment Hussars a force to be reckoned with.



### TRAINING

Hussars undergo rigorous training, focusing on reconnaissance techniques, airborne, marksmanship, and survival skills. They undergo specialized courses in intelligence gathering, combat tracking, and operating in urban and rural environments as well as parachute ranger school. The Hussars are also responsible for the the training of the Home Guard also known as the Hemvärnet.

### EQUIPMENT

**Firearms:** The Ak 4 (Swedish: Automatkanbin 4) is a Swedish-made version of the Heckler & Koch G3A3 battle rifle. It has been produced in several versions, with minor changes and upgrades.

The SAKO TRG-21/41 (short for Finnish: "Tarkkuuskivääri Riihimäki G-sarja", "Riihimäki Precision Rifle G-series") is a bolt-action sniper rifle available in .308, .800 Win Mag and .338 Lapua Magnum options.

**Carl Gustav M3 recoilless rifle:** A lightweight and portable anti-tank weapon utilized for engaging armored targets or fortified positions.

**Heckler & Koch G3 battle rifle:** A reliable and powerful rifle chambered for 7.62x51mm NATO ammunition, suitable for medium to long-range engagements.

**Specialized Gear:** AN/PVS-14 Night Vision Monocular: State-of-the-art night vision device providing enhanced visibility in low-light or nighttime environments.

The Hussars employed the Volvo Cross Country C303, (Tgb 11, "Terrängbil 11", translated as "Terrain Vehicle 11"), a rugged, versatile and reliable off road 4x4 also available in a 6x6 option.

The Bandvagn 206 is a tracked articulated, all-terrain carrier developed for the Swedish Army. It consists of two units, with all four tracks powered. It can carry up to 17 people, 6 in the front compartment, 11 in the rear. The trailer unit can be adapted for different uses.

### TACTICS

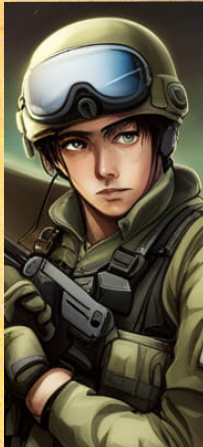

# KUSTJÄGARNA

The 202nd Coastal Ranger Company is an amphibious special operations capable ranger unit within the Swedish Amphibious Corps, which is the maritime land force arm of the Swedish Navy.

## HISTORY

The Kustjagarna, known as the Coastal Rangers, has a storied history rooted in the coastal defense of Sweden. Originating from the Coastal Artillery units of the late 19th century, the modern Kustjagarna has a focus on coastal surveillance, amphibious operations, special reconnaissance, and maritime interdiction, the unit has undergone extensive modernization and training to enhance its capabilities. Today, the Kustjagarna remains a vital component of Sweden's coastal defense strategy, safeguarding the nation's maritime territories with unwavering dedication and expertise.

## CAPABILITIES

**Amphibious Operations:** The Kustjagarna is trained in amphibious assault techniques, allowing them to conduct swift and effective landing operations on coastal areas and islands.

**Special Reconnaissance:** They possess expertise in gathering intelligence through special reconnaissance missions, utilizing their understanding of coastal terrain and covert techniques.

**Boarding and Maritime Interdiction:** The unit is proficient in boarding vessels suspected of illegal activities, conducting search and seizure operations, and supporting law enforcement agencies in maritime interdiction efforts.

## TRAINING

The Kustjagarna undergoes rigorous and specialized training programs to develop the skills necessary for their unique coastal defense and special operations missions. Their training focuses on enhancing their capabilities in areas such as amphibious assaults, coastal surveillance, special reconnaissance, and maritime interdiction. The unit trains extensively in

boarding and maritime interdiction procedures to counter illegal activities at sea. Operators develop skills in boarding vessels, conducting search and seizure operations, and assisting law enforcement agencies in maritime law enforcement efforts. Given their operations in coastal and maritime environments, Kustjagarna operators receive thorough training in navigation, seamanship, and small boat handling. They become proficient in operating various types of small watercraft, ensuring they can maneuver effectively in diverse coastal terrains.

## EQUIPMENT

**Fast Patrol Boats:** High-speed boats designed for coastal operations, providing swift mobility and the ability to access shallow waters.

**Diving Equipment:** Diving gear, including underwater breathing apparatus, suits, and navigation tools, to facilitate underwater operations and reconnaissance.

**Small Arms:** The unit is equipped with a variety of firearms, including assault rifles, submachine guns, and handguns, for personal defense and engaging targets at close range.

**Night Vision and Optics:** Advanced night vision devices and optics, such as binoculars and scopes, to enhance visibility and surveillance capabilities during low-light or nighttime operations.

## TACTICS

The Kustjagarna deploys highly trained operators along the coastlines and archipelagos, utilizing a combination of advanced surveillance equipment and stealthy observational techniques. They maintain a constant watch, monitoring for any suspicious activities, maritime intrusions, or potential threats to Sweden's coastal security. When required, the Kustjagarna conducts swift and effective amphibious assaults on coastal areas or islands. They employ specialized landing craft and small watercraft to deploy their personnel, utilizing their expertise in beach reconnaissance and fast-moving operations to establish a foothold and secure targeted objectives.

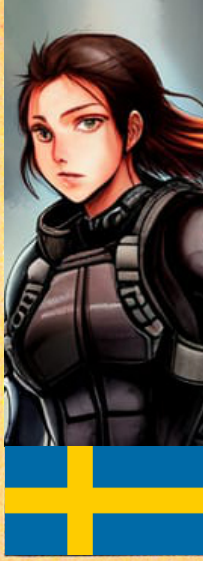
## OPERATIONAL THEATER

# SÄRSKILDA SKYDDSGRUPPEN

The Särskilda Skyddsgruppen, commonly referred to as SSG, is a specialized Swedish special operations unit tasked with providing personal protection to high-ranking officials, conducting sensitive operations, and performing specialized reconnaissance missions. With their expertise in close protection, intelligence gathering, and counter-terrorism, the SSG plays a crucial role in safeguarding national security and supporting Swedish foreign policy objectives.

## HISTORY

Established in 1985, the Särskilda Skyddsgruppen was created in response to evolving security threats and the need for specialized protective services. Originally formed as a small unit under the Swedish Security Service (Säkerhetspolisen), SSG rapidly developed into an independent special operations force. Their experience and operational success led to the expansion of their responsibilities and capabilities over the years.

## CAPABILITIES

SSG members are extensively trained in close protection operations, providing security and safeguarding high-profile individuals, such as government officials and visiting dignitaries, in various environments.

The SSG conducts reconnaissance missions, gathering critical intelligence through surveillance, reconnaissance, and clandestine operations. They employ advanced techniques and technologies to collect vital information in support of national security interests.

**Counter-Terrorism:** The unit is proficient in counter-terrorism operations, capable of responding swiftly and decisively to terrorist threats, hostage situations, and other high-risk incidents.

**Clandestine Operations:** SSG undertakes covert operations that require utmost discretion and secrecy. These missions involve infiltration, surveillance, and gathering intelligence in hostile or denied environments.

## TRAINING

SSG operators undergo rigorous and specialized training to develop their skills and capabilities. Training focuses on areas such as close protection, marksmanship, advanced combat techniques, intelligence gathering, parachuting, and amphibious operations. They undergo extensive physical conditioning, psychological resilience training, and are prepared for demanding and high-stress situations.

**Continual Skill Development:** Spetsnaz soldiers engage in regular training and exercises to maintain and enhance their operational capabilities.

## EQUIPMENT

The Särskilda Skyddsgruppen (SSG) relies on a diverse array of modern firearms to accomplish their specialized missions. Their arsenal includes the compact and versatile Heckler & Koch MP5 submachine gun for close-quarters engagements, the reliable Heckler & Koch HK416 assault rifle for various combat scenarios, and the Sig Sauer P226 semi-automatic pistol as their standard sidearm. For long-range precision, the SSG employs the Accuracy International AW50 sniper rifle, while the Carl Gustav M3 provides them with anti-armor capabilities. These weapons, along with others in their arsenal, enable the SSG to execute their tasks with accuracy, firepower, and operational effectiveness.

**Specialized Vehicles:** The SSG utilized various armored personnel carriers to transport personnel and equipment in hostile environments. These APCs provided protection against small arms fire and offered mobility over rough terrain. They also relied on transport helicopters, such as the Bell UH-1 or Eurocopter AS332 Super Puma, to rapidly insert or extract personnel during missions. These helicopters provided the unit with vertical mobility and enhanced operational flexibility.

## TACTICS

The SSG excels in providing close protection to high-ranking officials and other VIPs. They employ a combination of overt and covert protective measures, maintaining a vigilant presence while blending seamlessly into their surroundings. They utilize advanced surveillance techniques, threat assessments, and proactive planning to mitigate risks and safeguard their clients. They also conduct covert operations requiring utmost secrecy and discretion. Their operatives employ stealth, infiltration, and exfiltration techniques to gather intelligence, perform sensitive reconnaissance, or carry out specialized missions. These operations involve meticulous planning, meticulous attention to detail, and the ability to adapt to changing circumstances.

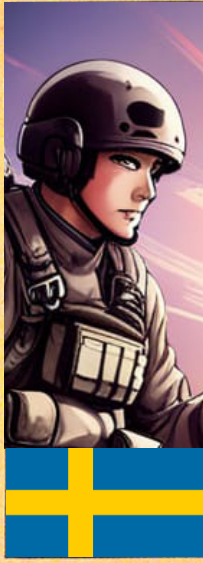
## OPERATIONAL THEATER

## NORRLANDS DRAGONREGEMENTE

The Norrland Dragoon Regiment, also K4, is a Swedish Army unit specialized in arctic warfare and special operations. Located in the province of Lappland, it was historically a cavalry unit that traces its origins back to the 17th century. It is a motorized infantry regiment with a primary focus on reconnaissance and security operations.

### HISTORY

The Dragoons have a long standing history that dates back to its establishment in the early 20th century. Originally formed as a cavalry unit, the regiment evolved over time to meet the changing demands of modern warfare. It played a vital role in defending Swedish borders, conducting peacekeeping missions, and providing support during national emergencies.

### CAPABILITIES

The Norrlands Dragoons possess a diverse set of capabilities, with a particular emphasis on reconnaissance, surveillance, and security operations. The regiment is trained to operate in arduous and demanding environments, employing specialized techniques to gather intelligence, conduct patrols, and secure vital assets. They are skilled in both mounted and dismounted operations, utilizing advanced equipment and tactics to maintain situational awareness and provide timely information to decision-makers.

### TRAINING

Members of the Norrlands dragonregemente undergo rigorous training programs to develop their specialized skills. ### EQUIPMENT

**Firearms: AK5:** The AK5, or Automatkarbin 5, is the Swedish variant of the FN FNC rifle. It served as the standard-issue assault rifle for the Swedish Armed Forces, including the Norrlands dragonregemente. It is a reliable and versatile 5.56mm rifle, capable of both semi-automatic and automatic fire.

**Ak4:** The Ak4, or Automatkarbin 4, is the Swedish variant of the Heckler & Koch G3 battle rifle. It was used by the Norrlands dragonregemente as a designated marksman rifle. Chambered in 7.62mm, it provided enhanced range and accuracy for engagements at longer distances.

**Carl Gustav M2:** The Carl Gustav M2, also known as the M2CG, is a shoulder-fired recoilless rifle used for anti-armor and anti-structure purposes. It was employed by the dragoons for its effectiveness against armored vehicles and fortifications.

**Glock 17:** The Glock 17, a 9mm semi-automatic pistol, was used by the Norrlands dragonregemente as a sidearm for personal defense and close-quarters combat situations.

**Specialized Gear:** The use of optical devices, such as binoculars and scopes, was essential for the dragoons to enhance situational awareness, conduct reconnaissance, and accurately engage targets at different distances.

**Field Rations and Survival Equipment:** The dragoons carried field rations and survival equipment to sustain themselves during extended operations in the field. This included items such as water purification systems, food rations, tents or shelters, and cold-weather gear.

### TACTICS

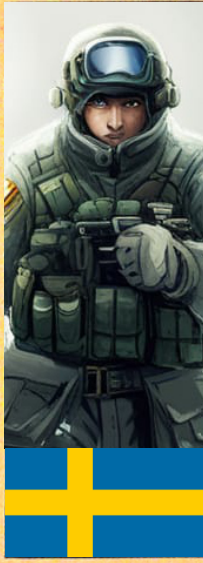

## FALLSKÄRMSJÄGARNA

The Fallskärmsjägarna is an elite airborne ranger battalion of the Swedish Armed Forces. Established in 1952, their primary role is to conduct airborne and special operations, including reconnaissance, direct action, and unconventional warfare missions. The battalion is highly skilled in conducting high-risk operations behind enemy lines and in challenging terrains.

### HISTORY

The Fallskärmsjägarna traces its roots back to World War II when Swedish volunteers served with British airborne units. After the war, the battalion was officially formed as an airborne ranger unit, and it has since been involved in various international peacekeeping missions and domestic operations. Created in 1952 by Captain Nils-Ivar Carlborg and modelled after the German and British post-World War II airborne commando forces, with the objective of creating a highly mobile force which had the flexibility to operate behind enemy lines and carry out long range reconnaissance missions to passively gather military intelligence.

### CAPABILITIES

The Fallskärmsjägarna possesses a wide range of capabilities that enable them to execute their missions with precision and efficiency.

**Airborne Operations:** The battalion specializes in parachute and air assault operations, allowing for rapid insertion and deployment into hostile or remote areas.

**Special Reconnaissance:** Fallskärmsjägarna operatives are trained in conducting covert reconnaissance missions, gathering critical intelligence behind enemy lines, and providing real-time situational awareness to the command.

**Unconventional Warfare:** Fallskärmsjägarna are trained in unconventional warfare tactics, such as guerrilla warfare, sabotage, and training and advising friendly forces.

### TRAINING

Fallskärmsjägarna undergo rigorous and demanding training to develop their specialized skills and capabilities. Their training includes:

**Parachute Training:** Intensive parachute training ensures their proficiency in airborne operations, including static line and freefall jumps.

**Special Operations Training:** Operatives undergo specialized training in combat tactics, close-quarters battle, marksmanship, navigation, survival skills, and advanced medical training.

### EQUIPMENT

**AK5:** The AK5, also known as the Automatkarbin 5, is the standard assault rifle used by the Swedish Armed Forces. It fires 5.56x45mm NATO ammunition and provides accuracy, reliability, and versatility in various combat scenarios.

**Glock 17:** The Glock 17 is a semi-automatic pistol chambered in 9x19mm Parabellum. It is a reliable sidearm favored for its lightweight design, high magazine capacity, and ease of use.

**Pansarvärnsrobot 55:** The Pansarvärnsrobot 55, or PVRB 55, is an anti-tank missile system used to engage and destroy armored vehicles at extended ranges.

**Specialized Gear: Climbing and Rappelling Gear:** Specialized equipment such as ropes, harnesses, carabiners, and ascenders enable operatives to navigate vertical terrains and conduct cliffside insertions or extractions.

**Demolition Tools:** Various tools like explosives, detonators, and breaching charges are used for demolitions, door breaching, and creating entry points.

**Survival and Field Equipment:** This includes items such as backpacks, hydration systems, camouflage clothing, cold weather gear, navigation devices, and medical kits.

### TACTICS

**Arctic Warfare Skills:** These units are trained in Arctic warfare tactics, focusing on mobility, concealment, and survival in extreme cold weather conditions. They have a deep understanding of the unique challenges posed by the Arctic, including freezing temperatures, icy terrain, and limited visibility.

**Survival and Evasion:** Given the remote and harsh nature of the Arctic, survival and evasion skills are crucial. Soldiers are trained in Arctic survival techniques, including building shelters, starting fires, finding food and water sources, and evading capture if necessary.

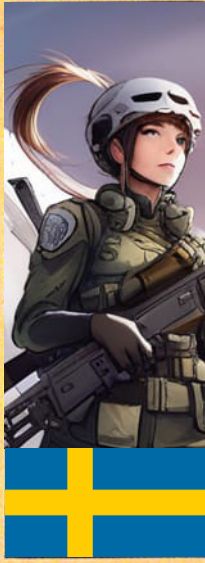

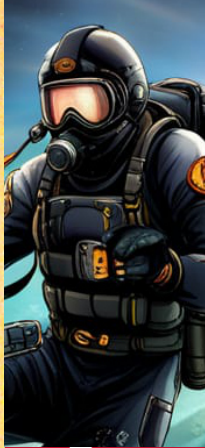

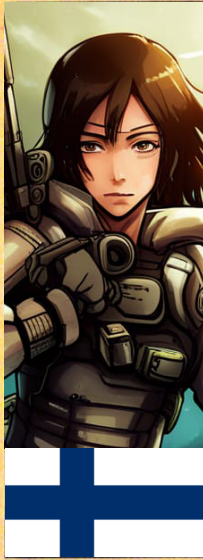

### TACTICS

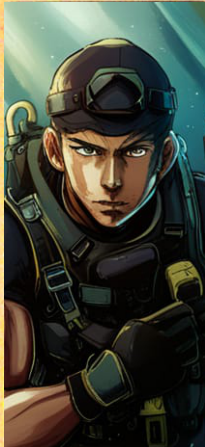
